
Instructions for visiting the tower with observation deck



round trip without oncoming traffic -

- Persons experiencing symptoms of acute respiratory distress are not permitted inside the tower with observation deck.
- There are 52 steps leading up to the lift hall.
- The only way up to the observation deck is by elevator.
 Only one person or multiple members of the same household are permitted on the lift at a

time.



Path along the observation deck

 All movement on the observation deck flows in one direction only (see sketch).

- The only way down from the observation deck is the 452 steps. This route will lead you through nine tower floors and past the old clockwork (clock floor) and the church bells.
- The tower floor 9 is located directly under the platform. Here you will find a contact person, seatings, background music, a short Hamburg film and you can choose a small non-alcoholic drink (hot or cold).
- Hand sanitiser is available before you take the lift and once you reach the ground again. Hand disinfection is mandatory before ascending.
- Please maintain a distance of at least 1.50 metres from others at all times.
- Use a face cover if at all possible. It is mandatory in the elevator.
- Please cough and sneeze into a tissue or your elbow and refrain from touching your eyes, nose or mouth.
- There are no toilets inside the tower.
